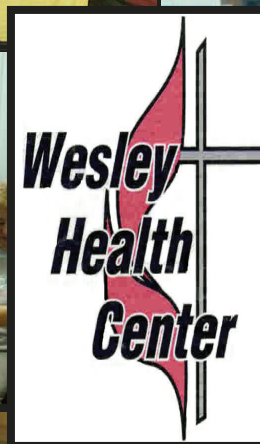

Since opening in 1993, WHC has provided safety-net services to the uninsured, treating acute and chronic illnesses, reducing emergency room visits, providing patient education to improve health conditions and reduce health risk, coordinating with health professionals and health facilities to increase services, and welcoming patients in an atmosphere of care and concern.

WHC is a non-profit, 501(c)(3) organization, governed by a volunteer Board of Directors, and supported entirely by grants, donations and fundraising events.

ELIGIBILITY

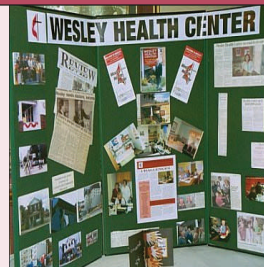
