



## **Prevention Specialist SAP CBITS Job Description**

Fayette County Drug and Alcohol Commission is seeking a Prevention Specialist to be part of a collaborative team whose goals are to reduce use and misuse of alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs and prevent problem gambling in Fayette County communities.

### **Summary Description:**

The Prevention Specialist will be primarily responsible for working with Student Assistance Program (SAP) Liaisons to coordinate SAP across Fayette County as well as the oversight and delivery of Cognitive Behavioral Intervention for Trauma in Schools (CBITS), a school-based, group intervention program designed to reduce symptoms of PTSD and depression while improving coping skills. Prevention Specialists are also required to participate in ongoing training that is designed to develop skills and knowledge in the prevention of alcohol, tobacco, other drugs, and problem gambling.

### **Qualifications:**

Minimum of a bachelor's degree in the behavioral sciences or related fields, as it is recommended that someone with clinical mental health training deliver the CBITS program. Exceptional communication skills, the ability to establish and maintain effective work relationships, the ability to manage complex schedules and meet deadlines. Proficiency in Microsoft Office. Ability to successfully prepare and deliver high quality presentations to various audiences. Strong organizational skills and capacity to manage multiple projects. Professional demeanor. Self-directed, while being able to function as part of a team. Must be flexible and able to adapt to changing circumstances while maintaining focus on clear solutions. Familiarity with the local community. Detail oriented. Must possess a passion for FCDAC's mission. Employee must have a willingness to travel (including periodic evening and weekend events) and access to reliable transportation.
